

Leroy Frahm, 86

July 8, 1918 - Jan. 30, 2005

WALNUT — Leroy Gerald Frahm was born on a farm northwest of Avoca, July 8, 1918, the son of Harry and Margaret Wolf Frahm, and was one of four children in the family. He attended Prairie Flower No. 9 country school and then graduated from the Avoca High School. He was a farmer in the Avoca, Corley, Walnut and Elk Horn areas until 1978 when he retired from farming and moved into Walnut. He lived in Walnut with his brother, Clyde. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church of Avoca. He died Jan. 30, 2005, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 86.

Leroy was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Virginia Piittmann. He is survived by his brother, Clyde Frahm of Walnut; his sister, Leona Piittmann of Hancock; nieces, Nancy Kelly of Hancock, Peggy (LeRoy) Hansen of Minden, Becky (Paul) Jensen of Underwood, MN; nephew, Randy Piittmann (Barb) of Hancock; seven great-nephews and one great-niece; and other relatives.
