

Hans Malling Frederickson, 83

May 8, 1916 – Dec. 27, 1999

HARLAN – Hans Malling Frederickson, son of Malling and Marie (Christensen) Frederickson, was born May 8, 1916, on a farm north of Avoca. He grew up around the Avoca and Corley areas and attended school in Avoca.

Sept. 10, 1941, in Omaha, NE he married Martha Lena Jensen. The couple farmed in the Walnut area, raising grain, cattle and hogs. They retired in Harlan, in 1980. She died Dec. 8, 1990, in Omaha, NE. He was an active member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. He died at his Harlan home Dec. 27, 1999, at age 83 years, seven months and 19 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his stepfather, Walter Olsen; his wife, Martha; and three grandchildren, Terry Brockman, Kenneth Monson and Kayleen Monson. Survivors include one son, Dennis (Linda) Frederickson of Walnut; four daughters, Fran (Brian) Penry of Aurora, CO; Carolyn (Gail) Brockman of Atlantic; Marolyn (Cyrus) Monson of Irwin; and Delores (Kerry) Kiesel of Shelby; one sister, Ruby (Ervin) Vollbaum of Shelby; 12 grandchildren; 19 great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Dec. 31, 1999, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan, with Pastor Jon Benson officiating.
