HARLAN – Nettie Belle Fymbo, daughter of Harry Lee and Hazel Dell (Wells) Densmore, was born April 18, 1921, in Defiance. Nettie attended school in Harlan and was a member of the graduating class of 1939. She then went to beauty school and was a beautician for several years.

Feb. 6, 1961, she married James "Timber" Fymbo at the Congregational Church in Avoca. After their marriage, they resided in Harlan. In May of 1997, Nettie moved to Missouri.
