Harlan - David Lee Greiner, son of Leonard and Marie Gunsolley Greiner, was born Aug. 30, 1953 at Harlan. He graduated from Harlan Community High School in 1974. David took a cooking class at Iowa

Western Community College which he was very proud of. He worked from 1975 to 1978 in Sioux City at the Goodwill Industries, for the Sheltered Workshop in Denison from 1978 until 1981 and Concerned Incorporated in Harlan from 1991 until 1995. He lived with his parents until Jan. of 1994 when he became a resident at the Country Care Center until Aug. of 1995. In Sept. of 1995 he became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan and it was there that he died Dec. 8, 1995 at age 42 years, three months and nine days.
