

## Delmar Goos, 81.

*May 4, 1926 - Nov. 1, 2007*

**MACEDONIA** — Delmar Henry Goos, one of eight children of Irvin Friedrich and Olga Louise (Bebensee) Goos, was born at the family farm home in Silver Creek Township near Treynor May 4, 1926. He was baptized and confirmed at Zion Congregational Church in Treynor and graduated from Treynor High School in 1944. He moved to a farm east of Carson where he established a life-long career as a farm owner and operator, livestock producer, and became a civic leader.

Delmar and Eileen Anna Schroeder were married at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Treynor June 29, 1947. They made their home on their farm east of Carson and were blessed with four children, Susan, Rozan, Warren, and Wayne. In addition to farming, Delmar helped manage the Macedonia Feed and Grain Company. His community activities included membership in the Iowa Farm Bureau, serving as a 4-H Leader, President of the Carson-Macedonia School Board, a member of the Western Iowa Development Board, A.S.C.S. Committee, Iowa Republican Party, and chairman of the Pottawattamie County Republican Party. He served two terms on the Pottawattamie County Board of Supervisors. Delmar and Eileen moved to a home in Macedonia in 1985. They had been married for nearly 56 years when Eileen died Jan. 27, 2003 at age 76. He continued to live in their home where he died Nov. 1, 2007 at age 81 years, 5 months, and 27 days.

In addition to his wife Eileen, Delmar was preceded in death by his parents; infant sister Marcella; brother Gilbert A. Goos; and brother-in-law Kenneth Kessler. He is survived by his children: Susan Goos of Macedonia, Rozan Weigel (Sam) of Harlan, Warren Goos (Glenda) of Carson, and Wayne Goos (Cindy) of Ankeny; ten grandchildren and four great grandchildren; sisters Louella Kessler of Council Bluffs, Darlene Kerber (Marvin) of Quincy, IL, and Eileen Graafls (Ronald) of Council Bluffs; brothers Gerald Goos (Shirlene) of Treynor and Donald Dean Goos of Omaha; sister-in-law Jacqueline Goos of Council Bluffs; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Nov. 5, 2007 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Treynor with Pastor Arlyn Norris officiating. Burial was in St. Paul Lutheran cemetery.
