

## **Georgia Goshorn, 88**

*May 3, 1912 – Oct. 14, 2000*

**SHELBY** – Georgia Maxine Goshorn was born May 3, 1912 in Shelby. She was the daughter of Charles and Emma Holtz Best and was one of six children in the family. She attended school in Shelby and graduated in 1930.
