

Glenn Goshorn, 85

May 14, 1914 - Dec. 1, 1999

CO. BLUFFS - Glenn Theodore Goshorn was born May 14, 1914, in Harrison County, son of William P. and Dora Brugge Goshorn, and was one of five sons in the family. He attended country school completed the eight grade.

He married Bernadeen Albertus Aug. 25, 1934, in Papillion, NE. They were the parents of three children, Darlene, Donald and Ronald. He worked as a hired hand on various farms in the area until 1943, when they started farming for themselves near Oakland. They moved to the Shelby area in 1945, and lived there until 1970, when they moved to Co. Bluffs. He worked for 9 1/2 years as a custodian for Omaha Public Schools, working at Highland School. He received his engineering license, third grade, during this time. He retired in 1979. He was a member of the Shelby Presbyterian Church. The couple celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary in August of this year. He died at Jennie Edmondson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, Dec. 1, 1999, at age 85 years, six months and 17 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers, Russell and Melvin; and his son-in-law, Robert Schuster. He is survived by his wife, Bernadeen; their children, Darlene Schuster of Shelby; Donald Goshorn of Temple Terrace, FL and Ronald Goshorn (Sherida) of Ames; four grandchildren; 4 great grandchildren; two brothers, Gerald Goshorn (Harriett) of Jerico Springs, MO and Dwendell Goshorn (Ruth) of Arcola, MO; two sisters-in-law, Darlene Goshorn of Colorado Springs, CO and Ada Goshorn of Massena; and other relatives.
