

Archie Graybill, 75

March 3, 1925 – April 16, 2000

BLAIR, NE – Archie Graybill, 75, of rural Blair, NE, was born March 25, 1925, at Persia, son of Albert and Gladys (Campbell) Graybill. He graduated from Neola High School in 1942. He served in the U.S. Army from 1944-1946. He farmed near Persia until 1951, moved to Omaha and was co-owner of a construction company.

He was married June 28, 1952, to Joyce E. Schneckloth. He farmed near Shelby until 1966, when he returned to Omaha and sold and installed garage door openers. He returned to farming in 1975 in Nebraska. He was a life member of Blair V.F.W., Persia American Legion Post 314, the Blair Fraternal Order of Eagles and "40 & 8". He died April 16, 2000, at his home near Blair.

Survivors include his wife and a daughter, Nancy (Dave) Pares of Omaha; a son, Mark (Paula) Graybill of Agoura Hills, CA; two sisters, Mary Emmons of Neola and Eileen Marr of Persia; a brother, Lee (Lois) Graybill of Co. Bluffs; four grandchildren; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
