

## **Brad Guill, 21** ✓

*Aug. 4, 1979 – May 13, 2001*

**PERSIA** – Brad Charles Guill, 21, was born Aug. 4, 1979, at Council Bluffs, son of Bruce C. and Sheryl E. (O'Neill) Guill. He was baptized Aug. 19, 1979, and was confirmed March 27, 1994, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Persia, where he was a member. He lived on the family farm at Persia, and graduated from Tri-Center in 1998. He attended Simpson College at Indianola, for three years and was co-captain of the football team. He had attended the spring semester in criminal justice classes at the American University in Washington, D.C. He had worked for the Duncan Bros. at Logan and at Applebees. He died May 13, 2001, the result of an auto accident at age 21 years.
