## **Georgetta Harvey, 79**

**Nov. 14, 1917 - July 17, 1994**

**Avoca** - Georgetta Lee Harvey was born Nov. 14, 1917 in Lenox, the daughter of Earl and Cleo Hufnagel and had two sisters, Doris and Helen. She grew up in Des Moines and graduated from North High School. She worked at Solar Aircraft during World War II and was active in a women's business society.

Aug. 10, 1946 she married Herman H. Harvey. They lived in Perry, Granger, Dallas Center, Leon and Avoca. Avoca has been their home for the past 29 years. They have one son, Robert, who lives in Minneapolis, two grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. She was a member of the United Church of Avoca and the American Legion Auxiliary. Her health had been failing for the past nine months. She died at Clarkson Memorial Hospital in Omaha July 17, 1994, at age 76.

She was preceded in death by her parents and sisters. Surviving family include her husband, Herm, son Robert, 2 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
