MANILLA – Minnie (Bandow) Hollander, daughter of Max and Anna Steckelberg, was born Jan. 3, 1903 at Irwin. She was baptized Feb. 7, 1904.

Jan. 24, 1924, she married Carl Bandow at Denison. Two children were born to this union, Alvin Bandow, Manilla and Ruby Determann of Early. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary for 46 years. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and the United Presbyterian Women. She was a restaurant worker and a cook and retired from this in 1976. She worked until 1988 as a housekeeper. She died July 20, 1991 at Early, at age 87.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Carl; her brothers, Henry, George, Maxie, Frank, Walter and Charles Steckelberg and sisters, Annie Miller and Ida Hilbert. Survivors include her children, Alvin Bandow and Ruby Determann of Early; a brother, John Steckelberg of Denison and a sister, Florence Lapel of Manning; six grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren.
