

## **Ada Whilimena Huffman, 89**

**Feb. 18, 1904 — March 7, 1993**

**HARLAN** — Ada Whilimena Huffman, daughter of Frank and Dora (Kiersch) Miller, was born Feb. 18, 1904, in Harrison county. She attended rural Harrison County Schools.

Sept. 22, 1927, she married Ben Huffman in Omaha, NE. The couple lived in various places until their separation in 1952. She worked as a waitress in Logan, and was employed as a cook at the Chicken Hut in Harlan for 13 years, and then at the Saylor Hotel for 15 years. In 1950, she moved to her home at 610-5th Street in Harlan. During the last few years of her life, she had lived at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. She died March 7, 1993, at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan, at age 89 years and 17 days.
