KIMBALLTON- Norma Lucille, daughter of Lewis Elwood and Elizabeth Wright Harris, was born March 28, 1925 in Milford, ME.

Jan. 5, 1948 she married Earl Hansen in Mexico, ME. One son was born to this union. Besides being a homemaker, she worked as a waitress and nurse's aide. They lived in Maine and Connecticut until Earl retired in 1991. They then moved to Kimballton. Earl died Nov. 25, 1991. Norma was a member of the Literary Club, and the Missionary Club and Bible Study at the Elk Horn Baptist Church. Jan. 4, 1999 Norma suffered burns in her home and entered Clarkson Hospital in Omaha where she died the same day at age 73 years, 9 months and 7 days.

Besides her parents and husband, she is preceded in death by three sisters, Beatrice Vesterby, Maurguerite Worcester and Doris Madeline, and a brother in infancy. She is survived by one son, Nels Hansen, of Shelton, CT; three sisters, Ruth Whitney and Beryl Fitzmorris of ME and Janette Lunden of OR; a brother, Lewis Harris of CT; a sister-in-law, Luceo (Byron) Nielsen, of Kimballton; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 12, 1999 at the Elk Horn Baptist Church with Pastor Mike Marcum, Elk Horn Baptist Church and Pastor Fred Dana, Seventh-Day Adventist Church officiating.
