GARNETT, KS – Edith E. Hastert was born Feb. 5, 1913, in Elk Horn, to Ole and Emma (O'Brien) Olsen. She graduated from the Elk Horn High School.

She married Christopher G. Hastert at Panama, Nov. 25, 1930. They moved to Anderson County, KS, following their marriage. Nov. 25, 2002, would have been her 72nd wedding anniversary. She worked at the Anderson County Hospital as a cook for over 20 years. She was a member of Holy Angels Catholic Church, Holy Angels Altar Society and JJJ Club, all in Garnett, KS.
