Nov. 10, 1926 – Sept. 14, 2004

LOGAN — Harley Francis Heim was born Nov. 10, 1926, in Logan, to John and Martha (Kierscht) Heim. He attended Mount Hope Country School and graduated from Logan High School in 1944. He recently attended his 60th high school reunion.

Harley married Marvelene Williams Aug. 20, 1948, at her parents' farm near Harlan. The couple lived and farmed in the Hardscratch area southeast of Logan. Nov. 1, 1997, the couple moved into Logan. Marvelene died Feb. 17, 1999. He died Sept. 14, 2004, at his home at age 77 years, 10 months and four days.
