ELK HORN – Henrietta Maxine Henningsen was born to Elvina Gladys (Christensen) and Henry Hansen Feb. 25, 1923, near Elk Horn. She was baptized and confirmed at Walnut Lutheran Church in Walnut. Henrietta attended Monroe Township Grade School and was a graduate of the Walnut High School.

Aug. 31, 1941, she married Herman Greve at San Diego, CA. To this union three children were born. They farmed in Monroe Township until his death July 31, 1980.

Henrietta married Wayne Henningsen May 17, 1986, in Atlantic. The couple made their home in Atlantic where Henrietta remained until becoming a resident of Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn. She was a member of Elk Horn Lutheran Church. She died Oct. 26, 2002, at Cass County Hospital in Atlantic, at age 79 years, eight months and one day.
