## Duane Henry, 75

*Feb. 2, 1928 - Dec. 22, 2003*

**LAS VEGAS, NV** – Duane C. "Dewey" Henry was born Feb. 2, 1928, in Morris, MO the son of Robert and Alice Wiley Henry. He grew up in Harlan where his parents ran a gas station in north Harlan.

He married Beverly A. Stockdale April 8, 1951, in Princeton, MO. Dewey worked at F.M.C. for 20 years and served in the Navy. They had formerly lived in Cedar Rapids. He died Dec. 22, 2003, at his home after a long illness.
