

## Ella Heyes, 89

*Dec. 19, 1915 - May 19, 2005*

**HARLAN** — Ella Heyes was born Dec. 19, 1915, to Timothy and Anne (Ennen) Hunt near Hampton. Shortly after her birth, the family moved to the Boone, Stanhope, Gilbert area. Ella was educated in a country school there.

June 1, 1937, Ella married Eizo Heyes at Ramsey Reformed Church near Titonka. This union was blessed with four children, Dick, Marlene, Leona and Joann. The family farmed near Titonka until 1959, when they moved to Mason City. Ella was a cook for some restaurants in Mason City for many years. In July of 1999, she moved to Harlan to be closer to family. She died May 19, 2005, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 89 years and five months.

Ella was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Eizo, in 1989; son, Dick, in 1940; daughter, Joann, in 1956; grandson, James Paulson, in 1966; five sisters, Mary, Hattie, Florence, Elizabeth and Annie; and three brothers, Bob, Fred and John. Survivors include two daughters, Marlene Cavin (David) of Council Bluffs and Leona Fletcher (Charles) of Harlan; three grandchildren, Duane (Marge) Paulson of Omaha, NE; Robbin Langhoff and Karen Barry, both of Council Bluffs; one great-granddaughter; eight step grandchildren; 26 step great-grandchildren; and eight step great-great-grandchildren.
