COUNCIL BLUFFS – Norbert F. "Nub" Hoffmann was born May 6, 1934, in Panama, to Frederick and Patricia (Buckley) Hoffmann. He had lived in Council Bluffs since the early 1960's. He was a 1951 graduate of St. Mary's High School in Panamá. He served four years in the U.S. Air Force. He was a member of Queen of the Apostles Catholic Church. He died April 4, 2004, at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs, at age 69.

Nub was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Patsy Hoffmann, Aug. 6, 1996; daughter, Katherine, in 1962; and sister, Mary Anne Keane, in 1957.
