CLINTONVILLE — Roberta J. Hoffmann was born Feb. 24, 1932, in Persia, the daughter of Edgar and Elizabeth (Ditzler) Thordsen.

June 30, 1957, Roberta married Rev. Franklin L.W. Hoffmann, Jr. in Tigerton, WI. The couple ministered in many communities over a 45 year period including Zion Lutheran in Flagler, CO; Immanuel and Trinity Lutheran Churches in Holton, KS; St. John's Lutheran Church in Elmore, MN; Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Morristown, MN; and Luther Memorial Church in Gleason, WI. The couple retired in 1987, but continued their ministry as interim at various churches. Rev. Hoffmann died Jan. 5, 2002. Roberta became a member of St. Martin Lutheran Church in Clintonville, WI in 2004. She was always very active in the churches they served, but was also involved with different 4-H clubs along the way. She died June 19, 2006, at her daughter's home in the Township of Belle Plaine, Shawano County, WI at age 74.

Roberta was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Rev. Franklin L.W. Hoffmann, Jr.; and a sister, Geri Olson.
