ROSELLE, IL - Ann Louise Holland, daughter of Robert F. and Ruby Leona (Wiig) Holland, was born Sept. 23, 1952, at Storm Lake. She lived and attended school in various places as her father was employed by the railroad. She graduated from high school in Belvidere, IL, and then attended college at Rockford, IL, for one year. She worked for the telephone company in Belvidere and then as a private secretary in the Chicago area, before becoming a sales secretary for Thomas Interior Systems, Incorporated in Elmhurst, IL.
