PANAMA - Chad Justin Huebert, son of Neil and Cherylene (Smith) Huebert of Panama, was born Nov. 8, 1975, in Harlan. He attended St. Mary's Grade School through the second grade and then transferred to grade school in Harlan. He then attended Harlan Community High School, graduating in 1995. During his high school days he was employed at Fareway in Harlan. He grew to childhood on the family farm near Panama. Chad was currently employed by IBP, Inc. in Denison. He spent time rebuilding cars with his dad and working with anything that required details, especially art work. He was a member of St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic Church in Panama. He died at St. Joseph's Hospital in Omaha, April 22, 1998, as the result of an automobile accident at age 22 years, five months and 14 days.
