PERSIA — Ruth A. Iwen was born March 1, 1914, in Shelby, to Wm. C. and Emma (Erickson) Peterson. She grew up on the family farm with her parents and sister, Elsie, and brother, Glenn. Ruth graduated from the Tennant High School in May of 1931.

Ruth married Art Iwen Feb. 22, 1938, the anniversary date of Art's parents and later the anniversary date of Art's brother, Roy, and wife, Dorothy. They became the parents of one daughter and three sons. They farmed near Persia until Art's death in 1975. Ruth has lived in Persia since that time. She was a longtime member of Trinity Lutheran Church and its Lutheran Women's Missionary League. She was a newspaper correspondent for the local newspapers for many years.
