HELENA, MT. — Victor E. "Vic" Jacobsen, 80, died Nov. 8, 1992 at St. Peter's Hospital, following a brief illness. He was born June 21, 1912, in Harlan, son of the late Hans P. and Anna M. (Christensen) Jacobsen. He attended schools in Harlan. He married the former Ellen F. Ladd March 2, 1937 in Harlan and together they moved to Helena in 1942. She He worked as a carpenter and was a member of the Carpenter's Union Local #153. He retired in 1977 from the Yuhas Millworks. He was a member of the Helena Trail Riders from 1946 until the time of his death. She preceded in death May 11, 1985.
