**ELK HORN.** — Jens C. Jensen was born July 25, 1904 in Shelby county, the son of Christian and Christine (Pedersen) Jensen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church, where he was currently a member.

On Oct. 4, 1930, he married Lazeta Struthers. They have made their home in Audubon and Shelby counties. During his married life, he has worked at the Exira Elevator and for the Nelson Jessen Oil Co. in Exira. He has also worked for the Audubon DX gasoline service where he drove a delivery truck and drove an Audubon school bus. While in Elk Horn, he worked as custodian of the Elk Horn Lutheran church.

He moved to the Salem Lutheran Homes in 1964 where he died March 14, 1967.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Lazeta on Oct. 14, 1967. He is survived by two daughters and two sons. They are: Gordon E.
