HARLAN — Lenore Virginia Jordan, daughter of Charles L. and Nancy (Perfect) Potter was born on Dec. 16, 1898, in Harlan. She died April 7, 1987, in Albany, OR., at age 88 years, three months, and 22 days. At the age of 13, she moved with her parents to Manilla, and was educated in the Harlan and Manilla school systems. When she was 21 years old, the family moved to a farm near Richland, MO. They continued to live there until 1922, when the family moved back to Harlan.

She married Lester F. Jordan on June 17, 1924, in Harlan. Three children were born to this union. After they were married, they moved to a farm near Hartington, NE. In 1948, they moved to Albany, OR., and this has been their home since that time. She was a member of the First Evangelical church in Albany.

She was preceded in death by her parents; and her husband in 1961. She is survived by two sons, Dick and Keith and one daughter, Melva LuRee (Mrs Backer) Cooper, all of Albany; eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Graveside services were April 11, 1987 at the Harlan cemetery with Jeff Nielsen, Pastor of Christ's church in Harlan, officiating. Paulay Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
