

## **George L. Jorgensen, 101**

*June 7, 1890 — June 1, 1992*

**KIMBALLTON** — George L. Jorgensen was born in Audubon county, June 7, 1890. His parents were George and Sarah (Stone) Jorgensen. He was one of 8 children. He was baptized and confirmed at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton. He completed 8th grade in rural school and then went to Grandview College in Des Moines. He also attended Hyland College. He was in the U.S. Army during WW I and has been a former Commander of the Audubon County American Legion.

He married Dagmar Faaborg April 6, 1920 in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Kimballton. They had one daughter and lived in the Kimballton area for a number of years. He was a salesman, farmer and truck driver during his career. In the 1950's, he moved to the Des Moines area. He was a resident of Crestview Acres Retirement Home for 15 years before moving to Fountain West Health Center in West Des Moines in 1989 where he died June 1, 1992 just a few days before his 102nd birthday. He was currently a member of the Lutheran Memorial Church in Des Moines.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Dagmar in 1955; his parents and brothers and sisters. He is survived by his one daughter, Dorothy (Ernest) Gilman Baldwin Jr.; two grandsons and two great-grandchildren of Charleston, S.C.
