

Timothy Jacobs, 42

Nov. 4, 1958 – April 22, 2001

IOWA CITY – Timothy J. Jacobs was born Nov. 4, 1958, in Harlan, son of LaVern W. and Julia Maxine Hartman Jacobs. He attended St. Michael's Grade School and graduated from Tri-Center High School. He was known for his artistic contributions throughout his school years. He attended City College in San Francisco, CA, majoring in film studies. In 1987, he graduated from the University of Iowa with a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing. He was employed as a registered nurse in the Pediatric Intensive Care and in Post Anesthesia Recovery Units at the University of Iowa Hospitals & Clinics. He died April 22, 2001, at the University of Iowa Hospitals & Clinics from complications of a virus following a bone marrow transplant.

He was preceded in death by his father, LaVern, and his stepfather, James Nielsen.
