## **Dean Jacobsen, 63**

*Nov. 14, 1939 - June 13, 2003*

**HANCOCK** – Dean Paul Jacobsen was born Nov. 14, 1939, in Atlantic, one of two children born to William and Ione Reineke Jacobsen. He played drums in the school band and graduated from Hancock High School. He spent time in the Iowa National Guard that was stationed in California, and also worked at an elk hunting ranch in New Mexico, but much of the time, he spent farming in Hancock. He worked as a hired hand for farmers in the area. Dean died June 13, 2003, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital after a brief bout with cancer at age 63 years, five months and 29 days.

He is preceded in death by his father, William. He is survived by his mother, Ione of Atlantic; his sister, Caralee Gunselman of Modesto, CA; a niece, Leslee (Charles) Marlow and their children, Tiffani and Kembra, all of Pacific Grove, CA; and other relatives.

Graveside services were held June 20, 2003, at Oakhill Cemetery in Hancock, with Rev. Dr. Judy Flanegin officiating. Pauley Knutson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
