LAS VEGAS, NV – Brian Dean Jensen was born Sept. 25, 1954, to Phyllis (Rossean) and Donald Dean Jensen in Harlan. He was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan in 1954, and was a member of the Harlan High School Graduating Class of 1972. Following graduation, he was employed by Dubuque Packing of Denison and Western Iowa Pork and Jim's Meat Market of Harlan.

He married Roxanne Winquist in 1982. In 1983, he moved to Tucson, AZ, where he became employed in the construction industry. He continued working in construction after relocating to Las Vegas, NV, in 1990.
