MANNING – Bernard Allen, son of Conrad Jones, Sr. and Alma Sindt Jones, was born Feb. 8, 1941, on his parent's farm south of Manning. He attended rural school near his home and then graduated from Manning High School in 1959. Following his schooling, he worked for Carroll Auto Salvage for a short time.

He married Kathy Daniel Oct. 8, 1961, at Denison. They lived in Manning, and raised their two children there. Bernard worked at Manning Motor Company as a mechanic until his retirement in 1996 after 36 years. In 1970, he started a lawn care business along with his other work. After his retirement from Manning Motor, he worked at lawn care on a full time basis in Manning and surrounding communities. His son, Tim, joined him in that business in June of 2000. In his spare time, he raised rabbits. At one time he served as a superintendent at the 4-H fair. He had not been well for a number of years but continued to work with his son as much as he was able. He died at his home in Manning, April 15, 2002, at age 61 years, two months and seven days.

Preceding him in death were his parents; sister, Clarice Weinbrandt; nephew, Conrad Jones III; grandnephew, Nicholas Johnson; and grandniece, Marcia Lovelace.
