OKLAHOMA CITY - Paul Edwin Kaldahl was born Jan. 8, 1935 in Wolback, NE., to the Rev. Soren S. and Marie Kaldahl. Feb. 17, he became a child of God through the new birth of Holy Baptism. He was confirmed May 22, 1949, at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Harlan. After graduation from Oaks High School in Oaks, OK., in 1953, he went on to attend Dana College in Blair, NE., graduating in 1956.
