Ida Kate Kelley, 90

Feb. 5, 1902 — April 29, 1992

HARLAN — Ida Kate Kelley, daughter of Perry and Gertrude (Nichols) Rose, was born Feb. 5, 1902 in Guss, IA. She was raised in central and northwestern, NE., and attended country schools.

May 31, 1922, she married George Frederick Kelley in Ainsworth, NE. After their marriage, the couple moved to rural Panama. In 1945, they moved to Jacksonville. During the years in Panama and Jacksonville, the couple farmed, retiring in 1972. George died Nov. 14, 1976, in Harlan. She moved into Harlan in 1977, and later became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Jan., 1992. She was a member of the Tuesday Chatter Club of rural Harlan. She died April 29, 1992, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, at age 90 years, 2 months and 24 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, George; a daughter, Helen and ten brothers and sisters. Survivors include two sons, Perry of Harlan; and Harold of Altoona; one sister, Berneice Myrick of Kingman, AZ.; seven grandchildren; six great-grandchildren and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held May 2, 1992 at Burmeister Funeral Home with Rev. Harrison J. Kline, officiating. Perry Kelley, Jr., Jerry Kelley, Larry Kelley, Kevin Paulsen, Stan Hays, and Scott Lovett, casketbearers. Burial was in the Woodbine cemetery. Burmeister Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
