

Theodore Knudsen, 89

May 10, 1903 — Nov. 4, 1992

ELK HORN — Theodore Knudsen was born May 10, 1903 in Brayton. His parents were Peter and Minnie (Nelsen) Knudsen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Oak Hill Lutheran Church, west of Brayton. He was currently a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran Church. He attended Rural School Oakfield #5.

He married Harriet Pearl Kness Oct. 9, 1932 in Omaha, NE. They farmed west of Brayton until retiring and moving to Elk Horn in 1978. He died Nov. 4, 1992 in the Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife, who died in 1983; three sisters and three brothers. He is survived by four daughters, Norma Rasmussen of Walnut; Rosalyn (Mrs Stuart) Fallgatter of Elk Horn; Harriet (Mrs Paul) Nielsen of Des Moines; Linda Knudsen of LaMars; eight grandchildren and 15 great-grandchildren and one sister, Marie Jensen of CA.
