

Marvin H. Kuhl, 61

May 18, 1930 — May 6, 1992

CEDAR RAPIDS — Marvin H. Kuhl was born May 18, 1930, in Crawford Co., and married Helen I. Jensen, June 12, 1955 in Harlan. He worked at the Manilla State Bank from 1952 to 1980, first as a teller and on up to president. From May, 1980, to the time of his death, he was an assistant vice president at Brenton Bank and Trust Co. He was a member of King of Kings Lutheran Church and treasurer of Iowa District East Missouri Synod Lutheran Church. While in Manilla, he served as secretary and treasurer of the Manilla School District, treasurer of the city of Manilla, and co-owner of an insurance agency. He died May 6, 1992, in his home after a long illness.

He was preceded in death by his parents and three sisters. Survivors include his wife, Helen; two sons, Steven of North Liberty and Robert of Atlanta; two grandchildren; and a sister, Leora Webster of Des Moines.
