

Audrey Kimball, 77

Nov. 4, 1927 - March 9, 2005

JACKSON, MN — Audrey Jane Kimball was born Nov. 4, 1927, in Jackson, MN, the daughter of Everett and Alice (Meyers) Salyards. As a youth, she attended the Ward School on Depot Hill in Jackson and then Central School and Jackson High School, graduating in 1945. After her education, she worked as a bookkeeper and clerk at the Gamble's Store and as a clerk for the Davies Clothing Store in Jackson. She moved to Minneapolis, where she was a secretary for Gamble-Skogmo. She then worked in the office of the JC Penney Store in Fairmont, MN.

In 1950, Audrey married Randal Kimball in Kirkman. They lived in the Irwin and Kirkman area. They were later divorced in 1963. After the divorce, she worked for Chozen's Department Store in Jackson. In 1965, she worked as a deputy recorder until retiring after 20 years, in 1985. She remained in Jackson until she moved to Pine River, MN, in 2005. Audrey was a member of the United Methodist Church in Jackson. She died at the St. Cloud Hospital in St. Cloud, MN, March 9, 2005, at age 77 years, four months and five days.

Audrey was preceded in death by her parents in 1975. She is survived by her son, John Kimball (Jane) of Pequot Lakes, MN; a brother, Lowell Salyards, and his family of Rochester, NY; and a special friend and companion, Ray Bunderle of Jackson.
