## **Alfred Kjer, 80**

*Jan. 25, 1922, 1944- July 15, 2002*

**FREMONT, CA** – Alfred Earl Kjer was born Jan. 25, 1922 in Irwin to Peter and Mary Kjer. He graduated from Irwin High School in 1939. After serving in the Civilian Conservation Corp, he moved to California in 1941. He was a World War II veteran, having served in the Signal Corp in Italy and Africa. After his discharge, he was employed with Western Electric Co. for over 40 years. He died July 15, 2002 at age 80 in Fremont, CA.

His son, Randy Kjer, Jr. preceded him in death, as well as his father, mother, four brothers and five sisters.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, LaBirda Kjer; his daughter Virginia Kjer; daughter-in-law, Angie Kjer; four grandchildren; one great-grandchild; sister, Alice Ingram; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Services were held in Hayward, CA July 19 and burial was at San Joaquin National Cemetery in Gustine, CA July 23, 2002.
