Dec. 24, 1906 - Sept. 10, 2005

SUN VALLEY, CA — Eunice Marian Kolb, daughter of William and Addie (Clark) Kolb, was born Dec. 24, 1906, in Clay Township, Shelby County. She attended Clay #3 School and graduated from Elk Horn High School with the class of 1926. After graduation, she attended Methodist College of Nursing in Omaha, NE, graduating with the class of 1930. She did private nursing in Omaha for a short time before moving to Wahoo, NE, where she again worked as a nurse. In December, 1945, Eunice moved to Los Angeles, CA, where she continued her nursing career. In December, 1971, she retired. She remained in Los Angeles until October, 1997, when falling eyesight forced her to enter the Villa Scalabrini Retirement Home in Sun Valley, CA. She died Sept. 10, 2005, at the Villa Special Care Unit in Sun Valley, CA, at age 98 years, eight months, and 17 days.

Preceding Eunice in death were her parents; three brothers, Gordon Kolb, Lewis Kolb, and Charles Kolb; two sisters-in-law, Virginia Kolb and Elvie Kolb; and one nephew, Warren Kolb. Survivors include one nephew, Larry (Janice) Kolb of North Hills, CA; several great-nieces and nephews; and several great-great-nieces and nephews.

Graveside services and burial were held Sept. 17, 2005, at Monroe Township Cemetery in rural Shelby County, with Rev. David Swinton of the Monroe Chapel officiating.
