*April 15, 1977 - Aug. 30, 2005*

**PETERSBURG, NE** — Kelly Lynn Kramer, daughter of Dean and Kate (Starman) Kramer, was born April 15, 1977, at Tilden, NE. She was baptized and confirmed at St. John the Baptist Church in Petersburg. She attended school at Petersburg Public School and graduated in 1995. Kelly attended Wayne State College and graduated in December of 1999. During her time at Wayne, she was a member of STRIDE, the Newman Club, and she did work-study at the campus library. She lived in Fremont where she worked at Preschools and Daycare in Fremont and Omaha. She returned to Petersburg in August of 2002. She worked as a substitute para-educator at Boone Central Elementary School and Junior High. She was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in Petersburg. Kelly died Aug. 30, 2005, after a lengthy illness at the Wolf Memorial Good Samaritan Center in Albion, NE, at age 28 years.
