OSMOND, NE — Lucille Rose, daughter of Nick and Anna (Weihs) Gubbels was born Oct. 31, 1921, in Shelby County. She grew up on a farm outside Westphalia, and graduated from St. Boniface in Westphalia.

Lucille married Norbert Nickolas Krienert Oct. 18, 1945, at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia. Lucille then moved with her husband to the Krienert farm 2 1/2 miles south of Osmond, NE where they lived and farmed for 44 years and were the parents of 12 children. In 1989, the couple retired from farming and moved into Osmond. She was an active member of St. Mary's Church, its Guild and the Christian Mothers. She died Aug. 17, 2006 at Osmond General Hospital at age 84 years, nine months and 17 days.
