

Margaret Anna Lange, 82

November 3, 1912-May 30, 1995

Elk Horn - Margaret Anna Lange, daughter of Chris and Magdalene (Jensen) Andersen, was born Nov. 3, 1912, in Rorbeck, Shelby County. She attended school through the eighth grade, and then worked with her father in his Rorbeck grocery store.

Feb. 21, 1934, she married Alvin Leo Lange at the Elk Horn Lutheran Church Parsonage. For many years, they farmed. After retirement in 1983, they moved into Elk Horn. He died Sept. 21, 1994 in Elk Horn. She was a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran Church. She died May 30, 1995 at the Salem Lutheran Retirement Home at age 82 years, 6 months and 27 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents and her husband, Alvin.
