Defiance- Larry James Larrison, son of George and Alma (Tempelton) Larrison was born September 9, 1929 at Micco, W VA. As a young boy, he moved with his family while his dad worked as a boilermaker in W VA. He received his education in W VA. Jan. 7, 1947 he entered the United States Air Force where he served his country as a supply clerk. After his honorable discharge Dec. 20, 1949 he worked as an iron worker near Novi, MI. In 1961 he moved to Omaha, NE.

November 10, 1962 he married Janice Wilwerding at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. Two children were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Defiance and he traveled around the Midwest working as a boiler maker and iron worker through Boilermakers Local Union #83 of Kansas City. He died at his home in Defiance May 9, 1995 at age 65 years and eight months. He was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Defiance and the Boilermakers Local Union #83 of Kansas City, MO.
