## Elizabeth Lorene Laughlin, 86 Feb. 20, 1910 - April 10, 1996

HARLAN - Elizabeth Lorene Laughlin, daughter of John Walter and Elizabeth Jane (Nantz) McCormack, was born Feb. 20, 1910 in Pleasanton, KS. She graduated from Pleasanton High School in 1927.
