HARLAN – Reese Edward Laughlin, son of Wilson and Jeannette (Nettie) Humphrey Laughlin was born Oct. 22, 1905 at Blue Mound, KS. Reese's parents died at an early age and his grandfather raised him and his brother at Pleasanton, KS., where he graduated from high school. He later attended Kansas University and Kansas State. He was in the cattle business with his brother.
