**HARLAN** - Richard Ivan Lee Jr., son of Richard Lee and Nancy Wiley Vogelzang, was born April 27, 1972, at Harlan. He had completed his junior year in the Harlan Community Schools, where he had been active in the F.F.A. Chapter and had served as a past reporter.
