HARLAN — Lois Steadman Lehman, daughter of Mable C. and Floyd D. Steadman was born June 12, 1908, at Beresford, S.D. She attended grade school and high school in Beresford, and received her degree from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles, CA.

Aug. 2, 1930, she married Carl A. Lehman of Beresford. Carl was Superintendent of several schools in S.D. In 1942, they entered into the Lehman Radio and Service business in Yankton, S.D. After the death of her husband in 1954, she worked at the University of S.D., and then taught school until 1972 when she retired and moved to Harlan to be near her daughter, Carol Moon and her family. She died June 22, 1993 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, just ten days after her 85th birthday.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents and a brother, Oliver Steadman. Survivors include her daughters, Carol (Ronald) Moon of Harlan and Gretchen Motchenbacher of Rockford, S.D.; 7 grandchildren; 7 great grandchildren; 2 sisters, Jean Langdon of Granbury, TX.; and LaVerna Hansen of Chula Vista, CA.; other relatives.
