Harlan - Margaret Lucille Pitzer Bishop Leuck, daughter of Frank E. and Elizabeth (Dick) Pitzer was born Aug. 10, 1909 at Glenwood. She attended school in Glenwood and graduated from Glenwood High School with a teaching certificate. She taught in a one-room country school near Glenwood for nine years before moving to California. When her first husband departed, she returned to Co. Bluffs and, as a single parent, raised her son, working many jobs before becoming employed by Pacific Intermountain Express as a payroll clerk, a position she held for 23 years.

July 12, 1977, she married Henry Leuck at Nashau. They currently made their home in Harlan where she was a member of First Christian Church. She died Aug. 18, 1996 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 87 years and eight days.

She was preceded in death by her parents. Survivors include her husband Henry of Harlan; her son Conrad Bishop (Elizabeth Fuller) of Philadelphia, PA; two grandchildren; two brothers, Franklin Pitzer of Glenwood and John Pitzer (Nina) of Mesa, AZ; and other relatives.
