

Gladys Annetta Linde, 71

March 17, 1920 — March 27, 1991

MANNING — Gladys, daughter of Marshall and Minnie Christensen Davis, was born March 17, 1920 near Fiscus, in Shelby county. She grew up near Harlan and attended rural schools near her home, through the 8th grade. She worked as a housekeeper for others for several years.

Aug. 19, 1942, she married Marvin Carson Linde at Omaha, NE. They made their home on a farm for several years and then moved to Aspinwall. In 1952, they moved to the family farm, making their home there until 1985 when they retired and moved to Manning. She became ill late this winter and was taken to Iowa Lutheran Hospital in Des Moines earlier this month where she died March 27, 1991 at age 71 years and 10 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; by her son, Arthur, as a teenager, and by her son-in-law, LeRoy Kirtley. Survivors include her husband, Marvin of Manning; her daughter, Linda Kirtley of Earlham; one grandson; two sisters, Ermal (Harold) Jones of Denison and Evelyn (Ross) Cadwell of Manilla; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
