Harlan - Darrell Vernon Linden, son of Oscar and Edith (McKeighan) Linden was born June 13, 1912 at Naper, NE. Darrell then graduated from Tennant High School. May 28, 1936 he married Velma Kirby at the First United Methodist Church in Harlan. Three sons were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in the Shelby, Pottawattamie and Cass County areas. In 1966 they moved to Tennant, and in 1970 moved into their home in Harlan. He retired in 1977.
