

Harvey Alvin Luchsinger, 83 ✓

SHELBY — Harvey Alvin Luchsinger was born near Minden, Sept. 18, 1909. He was the son of John and Alvina Kay Luchsinger. He was one of three children in the family. He attended school in Minden until he began farming with his father.

He married Helena Kundel Aug. 24, 1940 at Papillion, NE. They started farming on the Joseph and Minnie Luchsinger farm, who were his grandparents. They lived on the same farm until their retirement in 1979. He was a Community Committee Man for the Minden Twp. in the A.S.C. Program for more than 15 years. He also was a Commodity Sealer and Reporter during this time. He was a Minden Twp. trustee for many years. He was a member of the United Church of Christ in Minden. Upon their retirement, they made their home in Shelby. The past several years he has been a resident of the Colonial Manors Nursing Home in Avoca.

He died at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan Nov. 25, 1992, at age 83 years, 2 months and 7 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; and his brother, Melvin. Survivors are his wife, Helena of Shelby; one sister, Elva McLaughlin of Omaha, NE.; and his sister-in-law, Marie Luchsinger of Minden; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Nov. 28, 1992 at the Minden United Church of Christ, with Rev. Norman E. Meyer, officiating. Burial was in the Minden cemetery.
